- Note 1: The roster shall be strictly complied with. In respect of matters not covered by the subjects allocated special order must be obtained from Hon'ble the Chief Justice.
- Note 2: All fresh matter(s) coming by way of Daily Supplementary List shall be listed as per the roster.
- Note 3: Besides above, any other matter may be listed before the Benches, as directed by Hon'ble the Chief Justice.
- Note 4: Mention for listing of urgent matters in the two wings of the Hon'ble High Court shall be made before the Benches dealing with the assigned roster. However, where the same roster is held by two or more Hon'ble Judges, then memos shall be placed for orders before the senior most Hon'ble Judge.
- Note 5: If request for urgent listing/hearing of case(s) is allowed, the same shall be listed in the Supplementary Cause List. Caveat, if any, filed shall be distinctively mentioned in the Regular/Supplementary Cause List.
- Note 6: All fresh PILs and matters concerning environment shall be listed before First Division Bench.
- Note 7: Cases involving Senior Citizens (60 plus) as party or parties thereto and old cases filed up to the year 2010, shall be listed on regular basis and not kept pending in the Registry. At least five such cases per Bench shall be listed each day and while listing such matters, Registrar Judicial shall give them due preference under the caption "Senior Citizens' Cases".
- Note 8: While drafting and filing the pleadings/affidavits the relevant facts including order number, date, suit number, etc. should be mentioned. If the same are not mentioned in the pleadings, the same would be treated as defective filing. In spite of Circulars issued on this aspect and the availability of the High Court Rules, the numbering/passing Clerks are not verifying the said facts which is causing great inconvenience to the Hon'ble Courts while hearing the matters and at the time of writing orders/judgments. Hence it is impressed upon the Registry and the verifying/passing Clerks as well as the other Officers to meticulously see whether the pleadings/affidavits filed contain the relevant details and if the same are not mentioned, the case/cases shall not be numbered.
- Note 9: All the matters preferred against the orders/decisions rendered by the Commissions/Forums, which are either headed by retired Hon'ble Judges of the Supreme Court/retired Hon'ble Chief Justices of the High Courts/retired Hon'ble Judges of High Courts or the Member of the Commissions/Forums, shall be posted for hearing before the 1st Hon'ble Division Bench including the pending matters.
- Note 10: The Registrars (Judicial) of both the Wings shall ensure that 20 to 30 Contempt Petitions arising out of the Orders passed by the Hon'ble Judges who have already demitted the office are listed before each Bench on every working day. The oldest 100 to 150 petitions shall be listed before one Single Bench in chronological order and the remaining petitions shall be listed in the same order before the other available Benches. Contempt Petitions filed from the year 2007 onward as these arise from the orders of the Hon'ble Judges who have retired or have been transferred, shall be listed before Hon'ble the Chief Justice also while sitting singly. In addition the Contempt Petitions arising out of the orders of the Division Bench Judges, who have demitted the office by transfer or retirement, shall also be listed before the Division Bench presided over by Hon'ble the Chief Justice.
- Note 11: On Thursday, only final hearing matters shall be listed. Besides this, urgent Habeas Corpus matters, Bail matters and any other urgent matters, subject to the orders of the concerned Bench upon mentioning, shall also be taken up for hearing on the said day.
- Note 12: The cases listed before the Hon'ble Division Bench(es) and Hon'ble Single Bench(es) in the daily supplementary cause list on each day of the week shall be taken up by the respective Bench(es) at the beginning of the day.
- Note 13: Fresh cases (including fresh applications for grant of urgent interim directions) for next day listing, shall be listed in the Supplementary Cause List.
- Note 14: The cases listed in the Advance List shall be taken up by the concerned Benches first every morning in both wings of the High Court.
- Note 15: Fresh matters for admission and urgent applications shown in the supplementary cause list shall be taken up at the beginning of the second half of the day, whereafter the concerned Benches shall take up other cases from the Advance List and remaining cases of the Supplementary List.
