High Court is to procure approximately 450 Digital Signature Certificates for digitally signing the orders and judgments of the High Court and the Ditrict and Subordinate Courts of the State of Jammu and Kashmir. For the same, bids are invited from the reputed companies. Bid may be submitted in an envelope superscribed as "Bid for Digital Signature Certificates" up to 21-12-2018 4 PM in the office of the undersigned at Jammu. Bids will be opened in presence of the bidders/representatives on the same day after expiry of period of bid submission.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- (1) Time for completion of supply and installation is 15 days from the date of issuance of Purchase order.
- Only) and non-refundable tender fee of Rs 500/- (Rupees five hundred only) in the name of Registrar General High Court of Jammu and Kashmir Srinagar. However vendors registered with NSIC and MSME are exempted from payment of EMD and Tender Fee.
- (3) Rates must be quoted per item/certificate. Rates must be inclusive of taxes.
- (4) Bidders must attach with the bid the brochure of the products offered by them containing entire description.
- (5) Bidders shall also submit along with the bid a copy of the tender document duly signed and sealed by the bidder as an acknowledgement to the acceptance of the terms and conditions of the tender.
- (6) Validity of rates quoted should not be less than six months.
- (7) Certificates must be Class-2 Certificates with atleast two years validity.
- (8) The certificates must be compatible with the Ubuntu-Linux 16.04 OS as well

as with the Windows OS.

(9) The prices quoted by the Vendor shall be in Indian rupees, inclusive of taxes and not be subject to any price escalation.

Eligibility Criteria:

Bidder must have:

- 1. Registration Certificate for Sole Proprietorship Firms.
- 2. Registered number of GST where his business is located and Income Tax/Pan/TIN and must submit copies of relevant certificates with the technical bid.
- 3. Letter of authorisation from the Service Provider. If the Service Provider is the bidder itself, then letter of incorporation of the Service Provider.
- **4.** A Bidder who is blacklisted from any other Govt. institution is not eligible to participate in this tender. Similarly, at the time of bidding, the firms blacklisted/debarred in participating in any activities for fraudulent or corrupt practices by any State or Central Govt. or UT in India are not allowed to bid. For not being so debarred, the bidder must enclose a self-certified letter as proof.

Opening of Bids and Bid evaluation:

- 1. Bids will be opened as per Schedule mentioned in the Tender Document in presence of the representatives of the bidders if present.
- 2. The decision of the Evaluation Committee in the evaluation of the Qualification criteria and Commercial Bids shall be final. No correspondence will be entertained outside the process of negotiation / discussion with the Committee.

Note: High Court of Jammu and Kashmir may waive any minor informality or non-conformity or irregularity in a Bid.

3. High Court of Jammu and Kashmir reserves the right to accept or reject any Bid and to annul the Bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of Contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Bidder or Bidders or any obligation to inform the affected Bidder or Bidders of the grounds for Tendering Authority's action.

Payment Terms: -

Payment will be made on successful installation and testing of the ordered DSCs at the desired locations. Certificate of successful installation shall be provided by Registrar Judicial Srinagar/ Jammu or the officer/official nominated by them in the High Court. In District and Subordinate Courts, successful installation and testing will be provided by the Presiding Officer of the concerned Court under his/her hand and seal.

Bid Security (EMD – Earnest Money Deposit)

- 1. EMD Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only). Payment can be made through FD/DD/CDR/Bank Guarantee valid for three months in each case favouring Registrar General High Court of Jammu and Kashmir payable at Jammu.
- 2. A non-refundable tender fee of Rs 500/- (Rupees five hundred only) in the form of DD favouring Registrar General, High Court of J&K and payable at Srinagar must also accompany the bid.
- 3. Successful bidder will have to submit Performance Security Deposit of 5% of actual value of contract through bank guarantee in favour of Registrar General, High Court of J&K valid for the period of validity of the DSC.
- 4. The Earnest Money Deposit will be returned to the unsuccessful bidder within

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seven days of opening of financial bids and to the successful bidder within fifteen

days of award of contract.

Performance Bank Guarantee:-

1 The successful Bidder shall at his own expense submit within fifteen (15)

working days from the date of Notice of award of the Contract or Prior to signing of

the contract whichever is earlier, an unconditional and irrevocable Performance Bank

Guarantee (Annexure-I) of an amount equivalent to 5% of Contract value in Indian

3 Performance Bank Guarantee shall remain valid for the period of validity of the

- 6. The liability of us(indicate the name of Bank) under this guarantee will not be discharged due to the change in the constitution of the Bank or the Contractor(s)
